Comanche

Leaders of Native American groups

5. What was the (1) reason for and (2) result of the Archive War?

The government's archives and the capital remained in Austin

6. What was the main area of disagreement between Mexico and the Republic of Texas? [322]

Mexico did not recognize the independence of Texas

7. Refer to the Map on p. 319. Why would the location of Austin draw criticism from Texans opposed to it as the site of the new, permanent capital of the republic?

Austin was too close to the disputed area with Mexico, where it would be in danger of attacks from Mexico and Native Americans

8. What major policy of Sam Houston's did Mirabeau Lamar oppose?

The annexation of Texas by the United States

9. Which two (2) major events defined Mirabeau Lamar's policy toward Native Americans living in Texas?

The Battle of Neches between the Texas army and the Cherokee and ongoing battles between the Texas Rangers and the Comanche

10. What did Mirabeau Lamar focus on in his campaign for president? [325]

The failure of Sam Houston's peace policy to end attacks by Native Americans

11. Why did Sam Houston order the Texas Rangers to move the government's archives from Austin?

Houston wanted the archives protected in case Mexican troops attacked Austin

12. Why did Mirabeau Lamar urge the Texas Congress to reject the peace treaty with the Cherokee negotiated by Sam Houston?

Lamar believed that the Cherokee had been involved in the Córdoba Rebellion and were allied with Mexico

13. Which country was the first to recognize Texas as an independent country in 1837?

United States

14. What event successfully ended the second Mexican invasion of San Antonio in September 1842?

Battle of Salado Creek

15. What was one reason for the republic's money (debt) problems?

The government had borrowed \$1.25 million to pay for the revolution

16. What were the results of the Mier Expedition?

The Mexicans defeated the Texans in battle and 17 Texans were later executed

17. In what conflict with Texas forces did Cherokee leader Chief Bowles lose his life?

Battle of Neches

18. Which president is described in the following list:

Tried to sell the Texas Navy | First President of Texas | Wanted peace with Native Americans | Wanted annexation by the U.S.

Sam Houston
