Process Paper

Process Paper Due: 10 December 2019 (Tuesday) at the start of class. [MAJOR GRADE]

A **Process Paper** is a description of <u>no more than 500 words</u> explaining how you conducted your research and created and developed your entry. You must conclude your description with an explanation of the relationship of your topic to the theme, *Breaking Barriers in History*.

A separate <u>TITLE PAGE</u> is required as the first page of written material in every category. Your title page must include <u>only</u> the title/subtitle of your entry, your name(s) and the category in which you are working (Note: Please include "Junior Division" beneath your name(s) as indicated on the samples). **Only ONE (1) Process Paper submitted per individual or group.**

PROCESS PAPER:

<u>First section</u> should explain how you chose your topic.

<u>Second section</u> should explain how you conducted your research.

Third section should explain how you selected your presentation category and created your project.

<u>Fourth section</u> should explain how your project relates to the NHD Theme, *Breaking Barriers in History*. After this last section please indicate a <u>word count</u> in parentheses. (500 words)

- <u>Project Title/Subtitle (TITLE PAGE)</u>:
 18 pt. Arial, Calibri, Georgia or Times New Roman font (Bold) <u>ONLY</u>.
- Name(s) & Category (TITLE PAGE):
 14 pt. Arial, Calibri, Georgia or Times New Roman font ONLY.
- Body of PROCESS PAPER:

Typed double-spaced with 1" margins on all sides, 12 pt. Arial, Calibri, Georgia or Times New Roman font ONLY.

Note: Process Paper must be typed, double-spaced—10 point penalty if handwritten.
