**Albany Plan of Union**

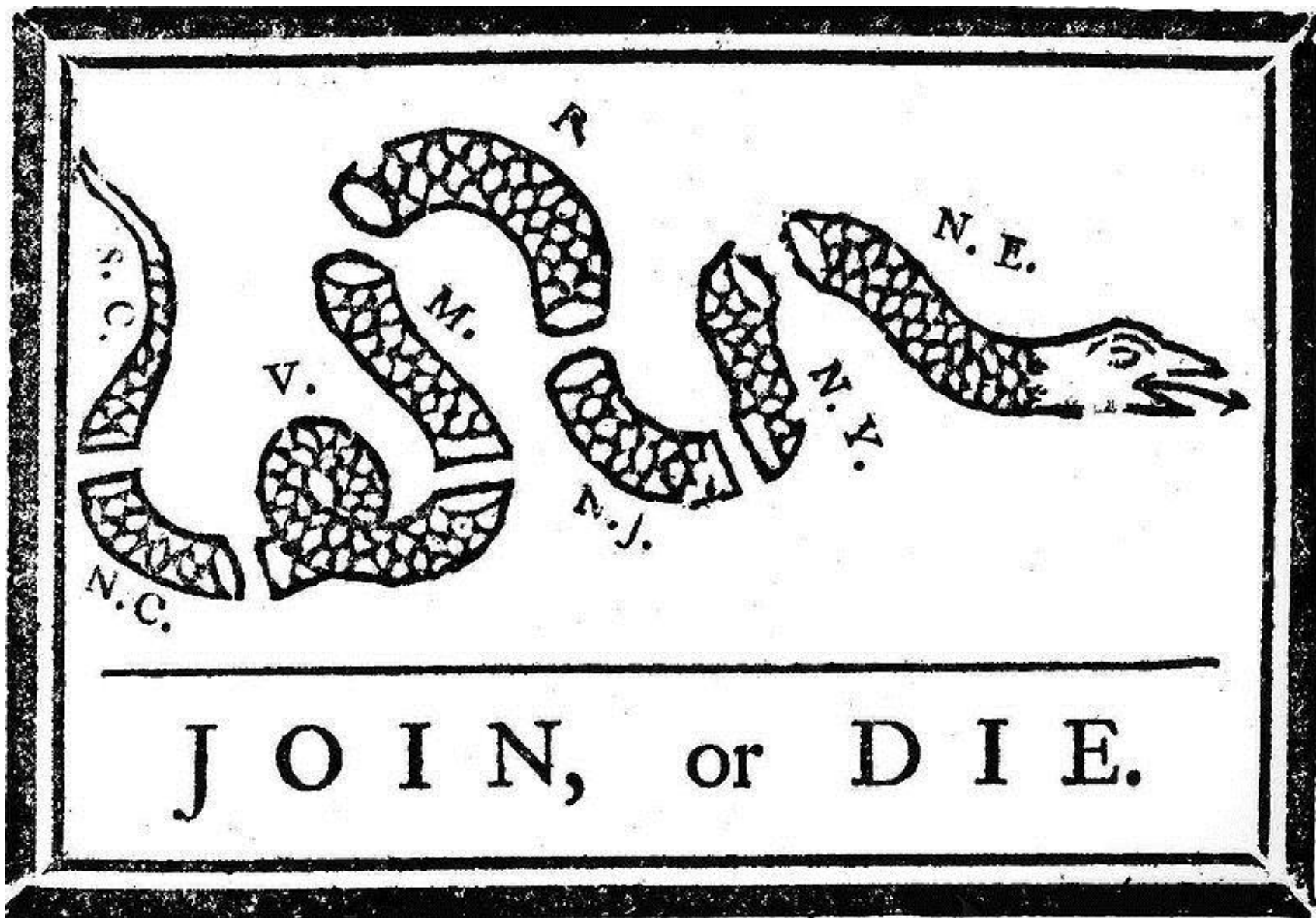

**began in 1754 --**

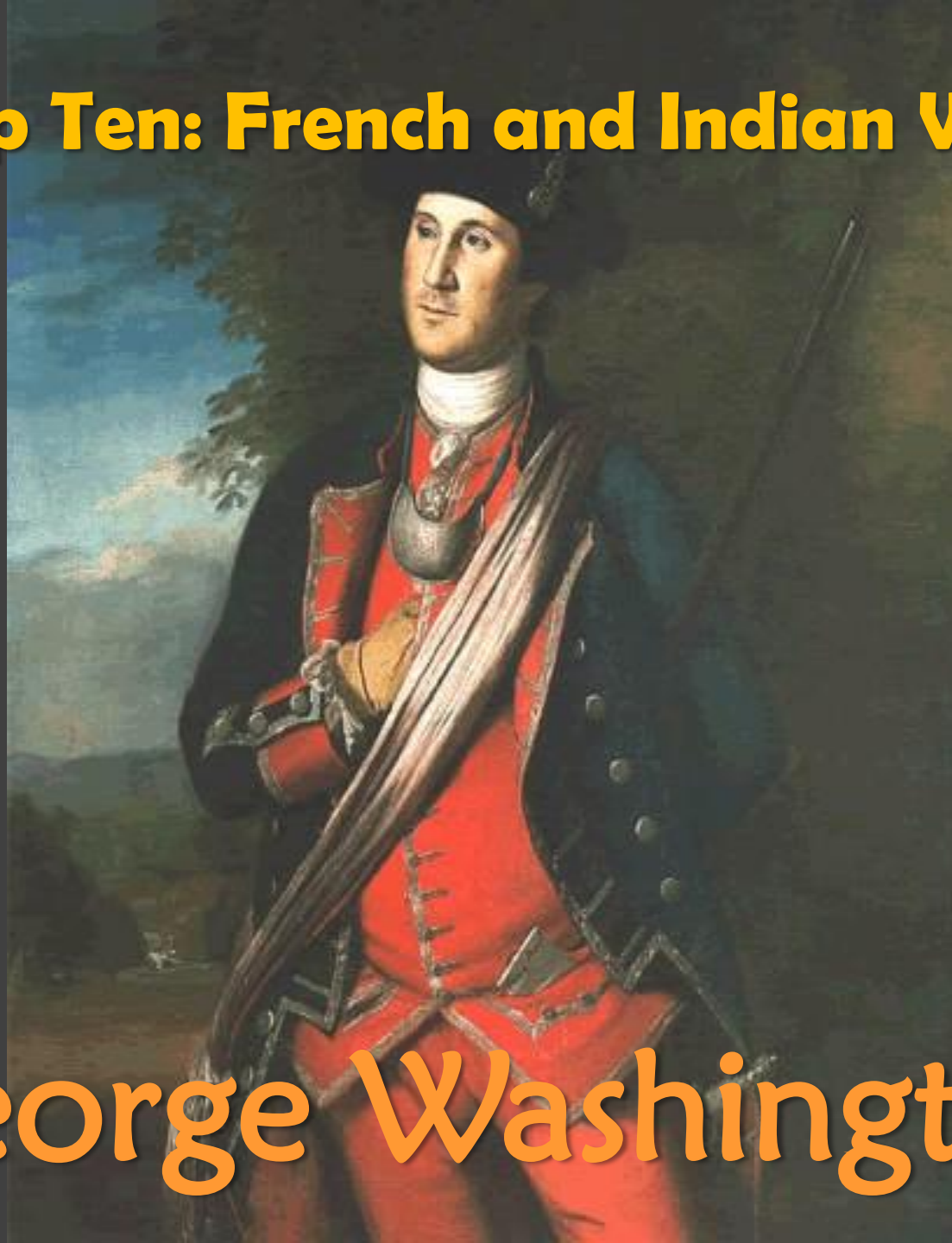
**known as the Seven Year's**

**...with a daring surprise attack.**



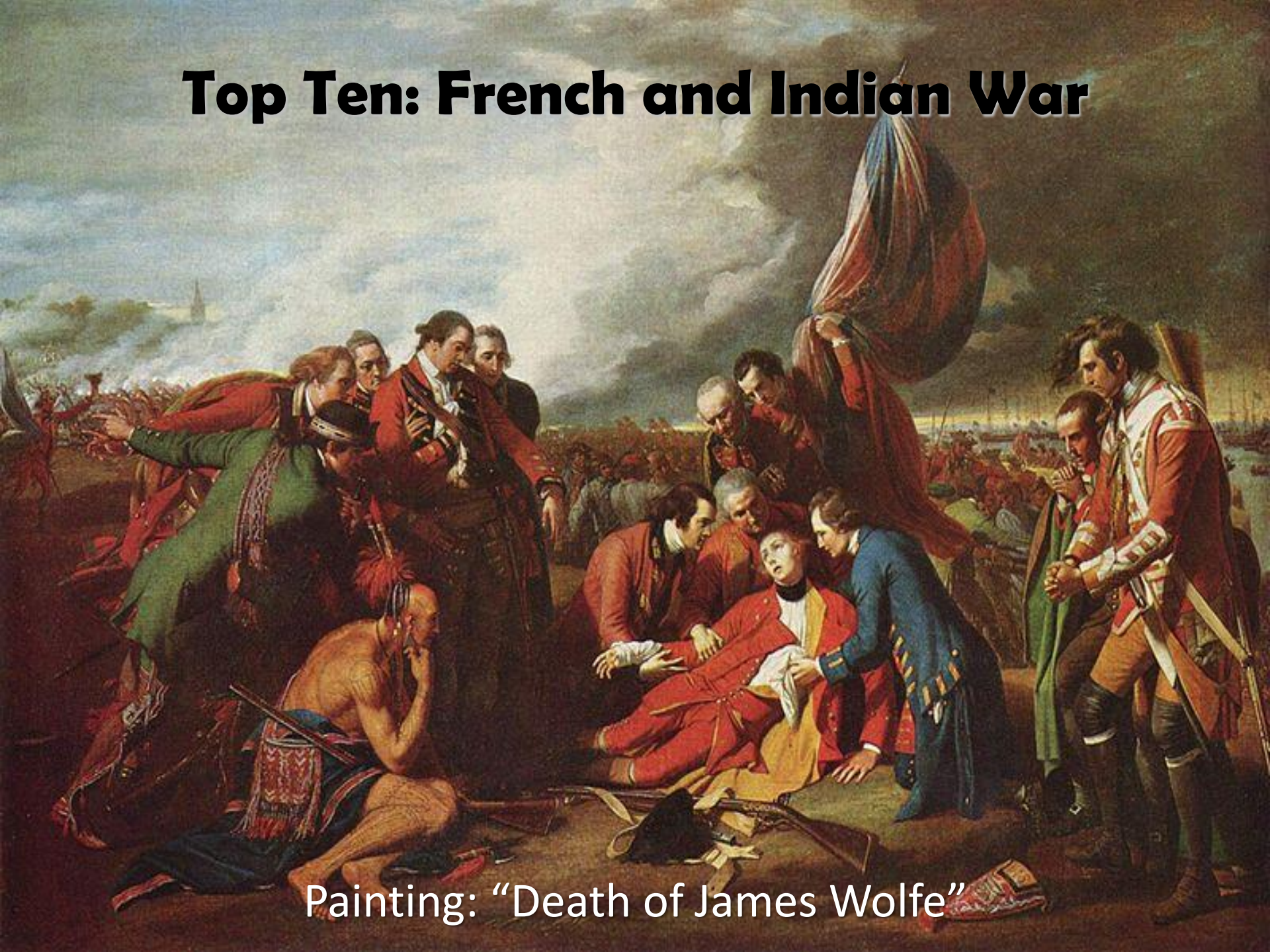
